



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN

BLOSSOM SCROLL BLOCK PRINT

SUITABLE FOR:

12+yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate.

TIME:

2 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Adigraf soft print

EC Block Printing colour

EC PVA

Paper or fabric

String

Lino cutting tool

Lino rollers ((brayer)

Bamboo sticks (you can find these in the garden section of the hardware or nursery) or skewers

Glass or large tile or similar to roll ink onto

METHOD:

Begin by designing your image and draw it onto the Adigraf sheet.

Using a U or V shaped cutter, cut a shallow outline of the work. Take care as this will be the outline of your print.

Remember to cut away from your body when using the cutting tool.

Cut away all areas that are not to be printed. Make sure they are deep enough that no ink will touch them when you roll it on.

Arrange your printing space so you have one area for rolling the colour onto the Adigraf and a separate area for transferring the colour to the paper.

Place a small amount of printing colour (1/2 tsp) on the glass and roll out to a thin film using the lino roller.

Roll the colour onto the Adigraf. Keep a rag handy so you can wipe away any colour that goes where you don't want it.
