



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 1

DINOSAUR HAND PUPPET

SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

VALUE:

Every child loves a dinosaur and what better way to own one as a pet than to make it yourself.

This craft activity is excellent for drama play and talks on dinosaurs in general.

It is also very good for fine motor and gross motor skills.

The children will have great fun running around having a roaring time.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Liquicryl paint

Recycled boxes and yoghurt containers

EC PVA glue

METHOD:

Take the recycled box, find the centre on the front of the box then mark it on both sides. When you have done this cut across the line and down the sides of the box.

The box should now fold back onto itself and become the dinosaur hand puppet.

Glue two yoghurt containers onto the top of the box for eyes and paint them. Paint a mouth and teeth on the inside of the folded area and then paint the rest of the dinosaurs head brown. Allow this to dry.

Now the FUN begins so have a roaring good time.
