



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 10

FARM ANIMALS

SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

VALUE:

This craft lesson leads to interesting talks about farm life.

Apart from creating conversational skills the children can learn about farm life and how the animals live, their purpose in life e.g. chickens lay eggs, cows give milk, goats give milk and cheese etc.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Liquicryl paint - brown
Recycled box
EC Kinder Rubs
A4 paper
EC Stubbies crayons
Scissors
EC PVA glue

METHOD:

Place Kinder Rubs under an A4 sheet of paper and get the children to rub over the animals with EC Stubbies crayons. Then have them cut the animals out.

Meanwhile design and cut out a barn from a recycled box and paint it brown. Write BARN on the top of it. Allow it to dry then glue animals on and in the barn.

TIPS:

Get the children to draw and cut out other things found on farms e.g. buckets, eggs, ponds, feeding troughs etc. You can ask the children to look for and cut out farm pictures from magazines.
