



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 11

SNAIL

SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

VALUE:

This craft activity has very good fine motor skills.

There are many craft ideas you can make from paper plates.

One of the skills shown in this particular craft is the ability to draw a coiled line around and around.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Paper plates

EC Liquicryl paints

Recycled cardboard

EC PVA glue

METHOD:

Cut the shape of a snail's head and tail out of the recycled cardboard and glue it onto the paper plate.

Then paint the snail's head, tail and the body in one colour e.g. brown and allow to dry.

Once the snail has dried, the children can paint a swirl in the centre with a contrasting colour, black in this example. Alternatively, give the children wool that has been dipped in PVA glue and get the children to make the coil and stick it in the centre of the snail.

TIPS:

Make a sew plate to teach children to thread things. Keep watching on our website for more interesting plate ideas.
