



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 2

# CRAZY FACE EMOTION HANDS

### SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

### RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

### VALUE:

This craft is very good for fine motor skills and it also teaches children about their own emotions.

Ask the children to draw on their hands - funny, happy, sad, angry or crying faces then talk to them about emotions.

This lesson plan invites the children to open the doors to their inner emotions and allows them to express themselves.

The values in accepting our own emotions are interaction with others, social, language and communication skills.



### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Funstix

EC jumbo stubby washable colouring pencils

EC Fun Kit paper

EC PVA glue

### METHOD:

Trace your hand on a piece of Fun Kit paper and cut it out. Roll the fingers down so as they look like hair and draw a funny, happy, angry, crying or sad face on your hand, then glue it to your Funstix.

### TIPS:

You can do the same craft using your foot instead of your hand. You can also use Educational Colours Liquicryl paints to do the faces on the hands.
