



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 4

# LEARNING MY FACIAL PARTS

### SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

### RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

### VALUE:

This craft activity develops a child's conversation skills whilst teaching them about the various parts of their face and what they are used for.

We have included a verse to help you, allow the children to fill in the blanks as they sing it.

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC matt paper squares

Brown paper bag

EC Ready Paste

### METHOD:

Start the craft lesson by asking the children to draw their facial parts including hair and ears on the matt papers then cut them out.

Then ask the children to glue the parts onto the bag in their correct facial positions. Tell the children to think of the colour of their facial parts not just what they are, eg: red for lips, blue, brown or green for eyes and the nose and ears are pink.

### TIPS:

Discuss with the children what each facial part is used for eg: the mouth to eat and speak with, the nose to smell with, the ears to hear with and the eyes to see with.
