



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 7

WE WEAR HATS

SUITABLE FOR:

2 to 5yrs

RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

VALUE:

This craft lesson is designed to teach children about the importance of wearing a hat.

The lesson leads into discussions on sun protection eg: wearing a hat and sunscreen when we go out to play.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Liquicryl paints

2 paper plates

Stapler

Hole punch

Hat elastic



METHOD:

Cut one plate in half, then shape it in a half circle to fit to the front of the other plate as a brim for the hat. You can use the full size plate to mark out the half circle for the brim. Then staple the brim to the other plate this will form your hat. Place a hole in either side of the full size plate to attach elastic to your hat. Now the hat is ready to have a beautiful design painted on it.

TIPS:

You can use Educational Colours Monster Collage Treasure Box to add different things to your hats for colour.

Have a sing along with the children.
