



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 1

# CLUCKING HEN

### SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs

### RATING:

Easy Moderate Hard

### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Sound Exploration, Decorate, Play.

### TIME:

1 session

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

*EC Foam Shapes*  
*EC Craft Pom Poms*  
*EC Craft Dots*  
*EC Matt Squares*  
*Goggle eyes*  
*Feathers*  
*Plastic string*  
*Small piece of sponge*  
*Plastic picnic cup*  
*Scissors*  
*Large needle*



### METHOD:

Make a small hole in the centre of the bottom of the cup using a large needle.

Pass the string through the hole and tie a big knot on the end so you have the length dangling on the inside.

Using craft dots, attach pom poms and goggle eyes for eyes and cut a beak from the paper and stick on.

Decorate with feathers and foam shapes, stick on with the craft dots.

To make your bird "cluck", wet the piece of sponge and holding the bird in one hand, pinch the string with the sponge and run the sponge down the string.

### TIPS:

Experiment with short and long clucks by varying the speed and length of string you rub. Remember to keep the sponge wet.
