



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 26

OLD WOMAN WHO...

SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Sculpt, Play

TIME:

3 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Mix-it

EC Paints

EC Chenille Stems

EC Foam Sheet

EC Clear Craft Gum

Newspaper

Masking tape

Wool for hair

Fabric

Goggle eyes

Satay sticks

Plastic juice bottle. The type with a rectangular base work well.



METHOD:

Scrunch the newspaper into a ball and attach to the top of the bottle with masking tape.

Mix up the Mix-it and spread over the newspaper to form the head of the old woman, sculpt nose and features. Allow to dry (a few days).

Cut a hole in the side of the bottle (your teacher can do this). This is to poke the animal puppets through.

On a piece of foam sheet, draw the animals the old woman swallowed. Cut them out and glue a satay stick to the back.

Wrap some bits of fabric around to form a skirt, shawl and top. You can hold them in place with rubber bands.

Paint and decorate.

You can operate your puppet by sitting her on a table and moving the animals into her belly via the side hole as you say the nursery rhyme.
