



**'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO. 6**

# SPACE SHUTTLE

**SUITABLE FOR:**

7 to 12yrs

**RATING:**

Easy **Moderate** Hard

**VALUE:**

This craft lesson could lead to interesting discussions about space exploration.

Have the children build a shuttle of the future out of any recycled items and EC's art and craft products.

**WHAT YOU WILL NEED:**

*EC Sticky Paint - red, white and blue*

*Recycled soft drink bottle*

*Recycled cardboard*

*Masking tape*

*EC craft rolls*

**METHOD:**

Cut out a pair of wings from the recycled cardboard. Then cut the soft drink bottle in half, length ways.

Use the masking tape to attach the bottle on the top of the cardboard wings then glue two craft rolls under the wings.

The children can then paint their space shuttles using a selection of colours from the new Sticky Paint range.

**TIPS:**

*Use EC's Fantasia Glitters on the shuttles to add sparkle to your project.*
