



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN

BIRD PUPPET

SUITABLE FOR:

7-12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate, Play.

TIME:

2 x 45 minute sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Craft Roll
EC Paint
EC PVA
EC Honeycomb mesh
EC Chenille stems
EC Glitter Fantasia
EC Goggle Eyes
EC Pom Poms
EC Matt Paper Squares
EC Feathers
Scissors
Stanley knife



METHOD:

Cut two holes either side of the EC Craft Roll about one third from the top, and where you can still reach in with your fingers.

NOTE: (Get an adult to help with this).

Cut wings from the EC Honeycomb Mesh.

Fold an EC Chenille Stem in half and make a small loop at the fold. Thread the ends through some of the holes in the mesh in each wing so it is attached.

Repeat for the second wing.

Poke the looped end into the holes in the craft roll.

Poke a 3rd chenille stem through each loop of the wing stems and twist on so it is secure (Refer to the picture).

Attach a large EC Pom Pom to the top of a craft roll for the head of the bird. Glue on EC Goggle Eyes.

Paint and decorate with EC Paints and EC Feathers.

To operate, pull down on the chenille stem to make the wings flap.
