



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN

FAIRY PEGGY

SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs and 7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate.

TIME:

1 session

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Wooden "dolly" style clothes peg
Artificial fabric flowers various sizes
EC Chenille Stem
EC Matchstix
EC Glitter Pom-Pom
Scrap fabric & wool
EC Clear Craft Gum
EC Fun Clay - Modelling clay
EC Paints
Scissors

METHOD:

To make the arms, twist a Chenille Stem around the peg, about 1cm underneath the "head" section. Fold the ends over to make loops for hands.

Pull apart the flowers into separate petals and cut so you can wrap them around Peggy's waist.

Start from the bottom layer and work your way up, layering the petals and scraps of fabric. Put the larger petals under the smaller ones. Use the Craft Gum to attach.

Choose some petals for wings and glue onto the back.

Cut some wool for hair and glue on. Put a smaller flower on top for a hat.

To make the wand, attach a Glitter Pom Pom to the end of a Matchstix and glue into the hand loop.

Make some fairy shoes from Fun Clay, these will act as a base to help Peggy to stand up.

Paint with EC paints.

Now you have a fabulous Flower Fairy with a magic wand to play with!
