



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN

LE CAT NOIR

SUITABLE FOR:

10 to 12 yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Creating and Making,

TIME:

1-2 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Chenille Stems - black

EC Craft Paper

EC PVA Glue

Cellophane

Scissors



METHOD:

This design is based on the famous poster for the 19th century French Artist Salon and Nightclub by the artist Théophile-Alexandre Steinlen. Look at the pictures of the poster 'Le Chat Noir' for inspiration.

Cut out a 'window frame' from the EC Craft Paper as a border.

Using the chenille stems, bend them and twist together to create an outline of your cat. You might find it easier to do a sketch on a piece of paper to copy. Make sure the cat fits inside your window.

Cut pieces of cellophane to attach to the cat and the window frame with the PVA glue. The cellophane will shrink a little with the glue, so make sure the pieces are slightly larger than you need.

Allow to dry. Place the cat picture in the window to allow the light to shine through, giving a pretty stained glass window effect.
