



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 13

# BUTTERFLY

### SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

### RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Fine motor skills.

### TIME:

1 session

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

*EC Matt Squares*  
*EC Clear Craft Gum*  
*EC Chenille Stems*  
*EC Glitter Pom Poms*  
*EC Honeycomb Mesh*  
*EC Glitter Paint*  
*PET plastic bottle*  
*Large paper clip*  
*Permanent marker pen*  
*Scissors*  
*Stapler*

### METHOD:

Cut wing shapes from PET bottle and honeycomb mesh.

Using the marker pen, draw some designs on your butterfly wings.

Staple the wings together in the middle, and paint using EC Glitter paint.

For the body, roll a matt square on an angle to make a "cone" shape, pointy on one end and open at the other.

Glue a large glitter pom pom on the open end for the butterfly's head, and attach chenille stem and small glitter pom poms for antennae.

Snip a small slit across the back of the butterfly's body, a little below the head. Insert one side of the paperclip in here and slip the wings under so it holds the wings to the body.

### TIPS:

*You can use the paperclip to attach the butterfly to things or put some string through to hang it up.*

*This butterfly will look pretty hanging in the window for the sun to shine through its glittery wings.*
