



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 20

HENNY PENNY

SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate, Play.

TIME:

2 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Matt Squares
EC Chenille Stem
EC Tru Ray Construction Paper
EC Craft Dots
EC PVA
EC Craft Pom Pom
EC Plasticine
Goggle eyes
Feathers
Scissors
Stapler



METHOD:

Cut a small piece of the Tru Ray construction paper and form a cone, glue and staple together and then cut top off to form neck. (Refer to picture)

Cut feather shapes from coloured matt squares and glue to the cone starting from the base.

Alternate colours until about two thirds of the way up, then cut two wing shapes and glue to the sides of cone.

Continue covering the body in feathers until it is filled.

Glue a craft pom pom to the top of the cone for Henny Penny's head.

Cut a beak from a matt square and glue on.

Decorate with feathers and goggle eyes using craft dots.

Shape chenille stems into legs and attach with craft dots.

Put dobs of plasticine on to feet to help her stand up.
