



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 26

CAT MASK

SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate, Play

TIME:

2-3 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Mask Papier Maché

EC Paint

EC PVA

EC Construction Paper

Tissue paper or greaseproof paper

Newspaper

Masking tape

Fabric and raffia to decorate

Scissors

Stapler

METHOD:

Tear up strips of masking tape about 10 cms long and stick them to the edge of your table ready to be used.

Tear a piece of newspaper in half and scrunch it up and mould it to form one side the cheeks of your cat. Attach a few bits of masking tape to hold it in shape and then attach to the mask using more masking tape.

Do this for the nose as well. (*Look at the picture*)

Cut ear shapes from the construction paper and glue and staple into place.

Work on a plastic surface for this next step so your mask will not stick to it. Cut the tissue paper into strips. Mix the PVA with a little water so it brushes on easily.

Brush PVA all over the mask and glue the tissue paper over the top.

Go over the edges of the mask, the paper and PVA will help to reinforce the connections.

Paint and decorate.
