PEG LEG PETE

SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate.

TIME:

1 session

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

Wooden "dolly" style clothes peg
EC Chenille Stem
EC Matchstix
Scrap fabric & wool
EC Clear Craft Gum
EC Fun Clay Modelling clay
EC Paints
EC Four Season paper squares or silver foil
Scissors



METHOD:

To make the arms, twist a Chenille Stem around the peg, about 1cm underneath the 'head' section. Fold the ends over to make a loop for the hand.

For the 'hook', cut some foil or Four Season squares silver paper into a hook shape and glue to the end of the chenille stem.

Cut fabric into a 'T' shape to make a shirt and glue on.

Make a belt from a piece of card or foam sheet.

Cut some wool for hair and glue on using EC Clear Gum.

Glue on a piece of scrap cloth for a pirate bandana.

To make the sword, cut a shape from the Silver paper and glue to an EC Matchstix and put inside the belt.

Make pirate boots from Fun Clay, these will act as a base to help Pete stand up.

Paint with EC Paints.
