



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 2

# EASTER NEST

### SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs

### RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Fine motor skills.

### TIME:

1 session

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Matt Squares

EC Tru Ray Construction Paper

EC PVA

Paper plate

Feathers

Bits of wool, string, leaves etc. to decorate

Scissors

Stapler



### METHOD:

Cut a small segment from the paper plate, fold edges together so you have a shallow cone, glue and staple together. (Refer to picture)

Fold the plate from the edge to the centre and cut small sections along fold a few centimeters apart.

Continue doing this around plate. (Refer to picture)

Cut Tru Ray construction paper into strips to fit through the cuts you have just made.

Start weaving the paper through the plate, curl the edges over and weave through the back. Continue weaving around the edges.

Weave in more paper, small bits of wool and string etc.

Decorate with feathers and then you can fill your nest with Easter eggs.
