



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 22

POP UP CHICK

SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate, Play.

TIME:

2 sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Foam Shapes

EC Chenille Stem

EC Craft Dots

EC PVA

EC Sticky Paint

EC Aquacryl

Goggle eyes

Feathers

Egg carton

Stick

PET bottle

Scissors

Stapler

METHOD:

Cut the egg carton so you have two cups joined together for the eyes. Glue and tape the stick in between them by folding them together slightly. (*Refer to picture*)

Make a tube shape from the foam, (*Refer to picture*), staple together at the back, attach over the stick, hold in place at top with a craft dot.

Cut slits on either side of the body and attach some wing shapes inside. Make some feet from a chenille stem and wrap around bottom of body to hold it to the stick.

Cut a beak shape and glue on. Stick on goggle eyes with craft dots.

Paint and decorate with feathers.

Cut the top off the PET bottle, cut it jagged so it looks like a broken egg. It's a good idea to slightly round the points as they can be sharp.

Paint.

When dry, put the stick through the mouth of the bottle, using the stick to manipulate your puppet, make your chick pop up.
