LEO LION HAND PUPPET

SUITABLE FOR:

7-12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate, Play.

TIME:

3 x 45 minute sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Craft Rolls (Asst'd sizes)

EC Mix-It

EC Paints

EC PVA Glue

EC Chenille Stems

EC Glitter Fantasia

EC Goggle Eyes

EC Pom Poms

EC Matt Paper Squares

Newspaper

Masking Tape

Fabric

Two sticks

Two small rubber bands

Scissors

Sculpting Tools



METHOD:

Scrunch a piece of newspaper into a ball and attach to the top of a medium EC Craft Roll with masking tape. Prepare the EC Mix-It and smooth over the newspaper, sculpting to form the lions head.

Sculpt a paw at the end of each stick. Allow to dry.

Use a square of fabric approximately 40cmx40cm. Cut a hole in the centre and push the neck of the puppet through. Glue on with EC PVA.

Attach two corners of the fabric to the paws using rubber bands.

Paint and decorate with EC Paints and EC Glitter Fantasia.

To operate, put fingers of one hand in the tube and use your other hand to operate the sticks.
