



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 4

PENGUIN POP-UP CARD

SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design, Decorate

TIME:

1 session

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Foam Sheets - Black and White

EC Craft Glue Dots

Paper from EC Super Black Pad

EC PVA

EC Fluoro Squares

Goggle eyes

Scissors

METHOD:

Fold a piece of paper from the EC Super Black Pad in half to form a card.

Cut out a penguin shape from the white foam sheets. For it to be a Pop-Up you need to make it about 3/4 the width of the opened card. Proportion the height of the penguin so you will have room for the greeting.

Cut out shapes for the penguins head and wings etc from the black foam and attach with the EC Craft Dots.

Attach a goggle eye with a Craft Glue Dot, position the eye a bit to one side so your penguin will fold in half easily before it Pops Up.

Position the penguin on the card and glue one wing to the outer edge of the card with a Glue Dot.

Cut out a greeting from the EC Fluoro Squares and glue it on with the EC PVA. Use the penguin as a guide in positioning the lettering.

Attach the other wing of the penguin to the outer edge of the other side of the card.

Now you have a fun Pop-Up card made from foam sheets.
