



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 15

# VASE OF FLOWERS

### SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

### RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Design Decorate.

### TIME:

1 session

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

*EC Matt and Gloss Squares (large size)*

*EC Chenille Stem*

*EC PVA*

*EC Glitter pom poms*

*EC Craft roll*

*Sticky tape*

*Pebbles or rice to weight vase*

*Scissors*



### METHOD:

Put a dab of glue on the end of a chenille stem and attach a glitter pom pom. Twist the stem into the pom pom so it is secure. Cut a paper square in half. Fold in half lengthwise and then make valley folds (like folding a fan). See *Picture*.

Wrap the paper around the stem and secure in place with a dab of PVA and sticky tape.

Wind the stem around the base of the flower. Press the paper out to resemble petals. Experiment with different colours and layers of petals.

Make leaves from strips of green paper, folded and glued.

For the vase, wrap a craft roll in a matt square and glue into place.

Fill the vase part way with pebbles or rice to weigh it down so it doesn't topple over when the flowers are in it.

Fill the vase with your flowers.

*Now you have a pretty bunch of flowers for Mum.*
