



## 'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 16

# WINGED HEART

### SUITABLE FOR:

5 to 7yrs

### RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

### LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Sculpture, Fine motor skills.

### TIME:

1 session

### WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

*EC Four Seasons Paper Squares*

*EC PVA*

*Paper plate or similar cardboard*

*Newspaper*

*Masking tape*

*Red cellophane*

*Feathers*

*Scissors*



### METHOD:

Cut heart and wing shapes from the paper plate.

Scrunch up newspaper and attach onto the heart to make it 3D, use strips of masking tape to attach it.

Brush PVA glue over the heart and glue on strips of red cellophane, overlapping them onto the back as well. When the glue dries this strengthens the newspaper sculpture.

Decorate the wings with EC Four Seasons paper squares cut to feather shapes and glued on with PVA.

Glue on feathers.

Attach some string to the back so your heart can hang up.

*Now you have a decorative winged heart for Mum for Mothers Day.*
