



'TEACHER RESOURCES' LESSON PLAN NO 9

CHRISTMAS GREETING GARLAND

SUITABLE FOR:

7 to 12yrs

RATING:

Easy **Moderate** Hard

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Construction skills

TIME:

2 x 45 minute sessions

WHAT YOU WILL NEED:

EC Honeycomb Mesh

EC Four Seasons Paper Squares

EC Paint

Cardboard (old cardboard box or similar)

EC PVA

Scissors

Stapler

METHOD:

Cut cardboard into a circle, and cut a hole in the middle so its like a doughnut.

Put the stapler on the inside and start stapling honeycomb mesh to cardboard. Make a fold in the mesh every now and then so it will fit around the circle. (*Refer to picture*)

Do an inner and outer circle of mesh in contasting colours.

Cut shapes from EC Four Seasons Paper Squares and glue onto back of wreath.

Cut two thin strips of cardboard and staple onto inner circle.

Paint greeting onto strips, or cut letters from paper and glue on.

Attach a piece of string or a paperclip to the back of the strip to hang up.

Now you have a beautiful garland to hang on your door.
